



You have been prescribed a medication that interacts with some common supplements and medications. Taking these tablets or liquids can result in your medication not working as effectively. Some of these are prescribed and others can be purchased over the counter from a pharmacy.

Rilpivirine (Edurant, Eviplera, Juluca and Odefsey)

Proton pump inhibitors, for example, Omeprazole	Cannot be taken together
H2 antagonists, for example, Ranitidine	Take 12 hours before or at least four hours after Rilpivirine
Antacids, for example, Rennie and Gaviscon	Take antacids at least two hours before or four hours after Rilpivirine
